

**RESOLUTION SETTING AD VALOREM TAX LEVY FOR THE CITY OF
HERNANDO, MISSISSIPPI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026**

WHEREAS, the City of Hernando now desires to set the ad valorem tax levy for the City for the fiscal year 2025-2026, pursuant to the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, and the Mayor and Board of Aldermen having carefully considered and determined the needs of the municipality and that the tax rate required to meet the expenses of said municipality for the fiscal year 2025-2026.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Hernando, Mississippi that the ad valorem tax rate and levies for the fiscal year 2025-2026 shall be as follows:

GENERAL FUND – on each dollar (\$1.00) valuation as authorized by Section 27-39-307 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, for General Revenue purposes and General Improvements, Twenty-eight and 27/100 (28.27) Mills.

MUNICIPAL BOND AND INTEREST FUND – on each dollar (\$1.00) valuation as authorized by Section 21-33-45 of the Mississippi Code, Annotated, Four and 82/100 (4.82) Mills.

LIBRARY FUND – on each dollar (\$1.00) valuation as authorized by Section 39-3-7 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, 68/100 (.68) Mills.

CULTURE & RECREATION FUND – on each dollar (\$1.00) valuation as authorized for park improvements and maintenance, Two and 0/100 (2.00) mills.

The total mills for 2025-2026 is Thirty-five and 76/100 (35.76) Mills.

Motion was duly made by Alderman Wicker seconded by Alderman Robinson to approve the Resolution Setting the ad valorem tax levy for the City of Hernando for the fiscal year 2025-2026.
